A Level Art Craft and Design - EDUQAS

Entry Requirements:

5 GCSEs at grade 4 or above including English.

Is this course for me?

If you have enjoyed being able to work on your own ideas over the last few years and love working in a range of media then this is the course for you. The AS year allows you to develop your art skills further and gives you time to experiment with a wide range of media. The classes are smaller than GCSE so you get time to discuss ideas each lesson and start to become an independent thinker and artist. Photography and digital art is a big part of the course. Seeing the world through a lens is a skill you can develop quickly.

Where does it lead?

Many of our students have gone on to study Art and Design at University. The course leads to careers in teaching, website design, games design, architecture, graphic design, fashion design, nursery care, art therapy etc.

How will I be assessed?

You will be assessed throughout the year on your drawing skills and the quality of your research. Working independently on your own ideas and creating innovative ideas increases your grade. The AS is assessed on one portfolio of work. A2 is one portfolio and an externally set exam.
