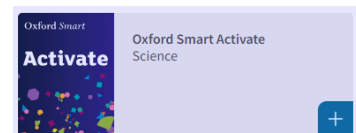

Who is Kerboodle for?

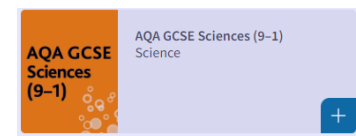
There is a kerboodle section for both key stage 3, key stage 4 and key stage 5.

Key Stage 3 is called Activate Smart.

- Year 7 is Activate Smart 1
- Year 8 is Activate Smart 2 and
- Year 9 is Activate Smart 3

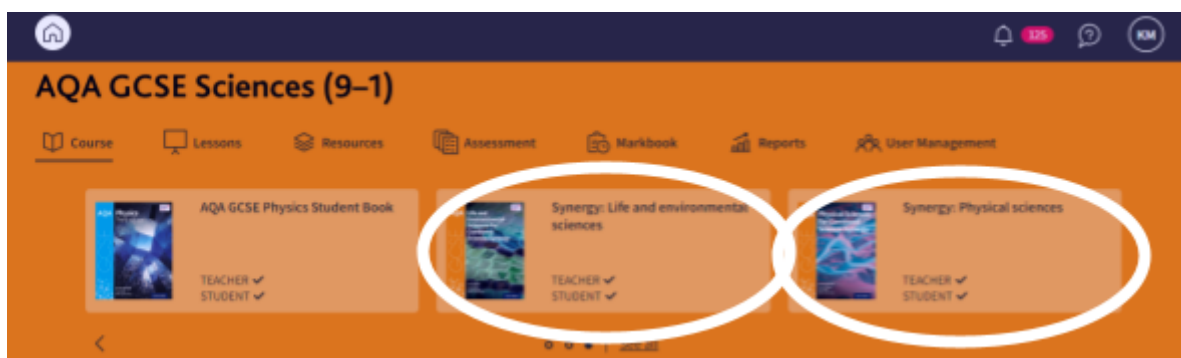


Key Stage 4 has several aspects to it depending upon the course students are studying. But students should click on AQA GCSE Sciences (9-1) as seen to the right.

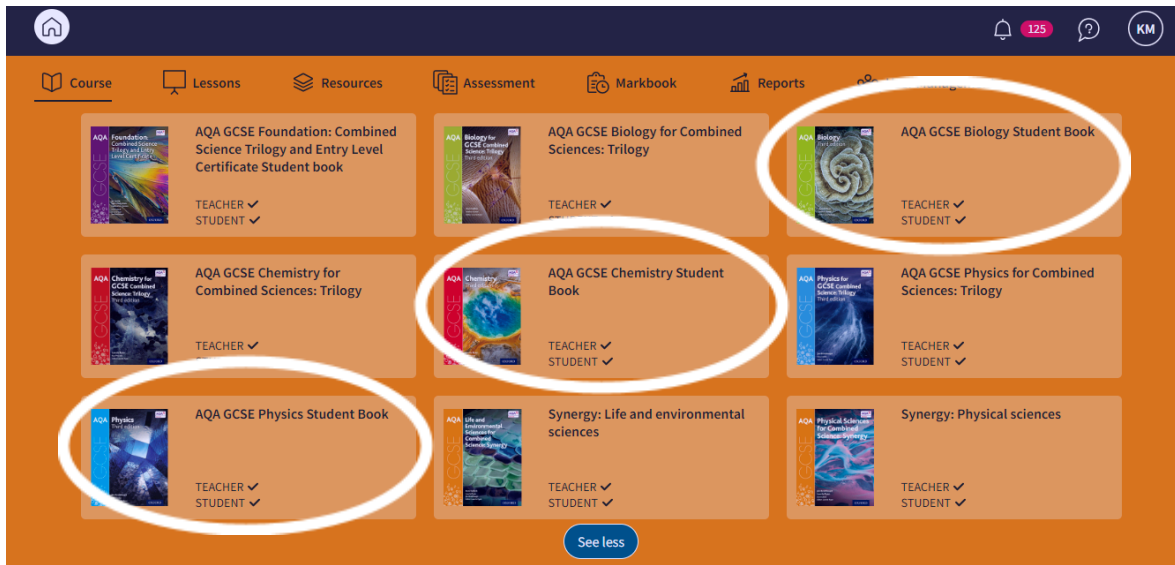


From here students should select the course they are studying.

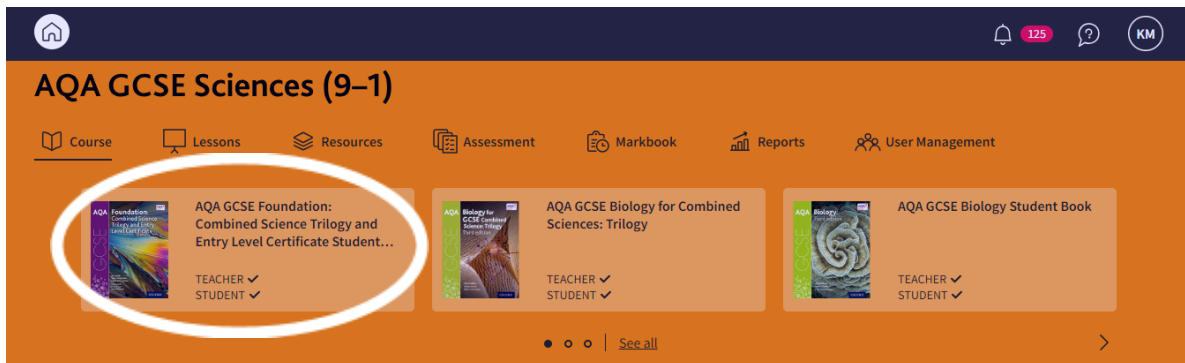
- Combined Science Synergy is the course the majority of Coop Academy Bebington Students study. It is composed of two textbooks as displayed above
 - Life and environmental Sciences (for Year 10)
 - Physical Sciences (for Year 11 and post end of year exams for Year 10)



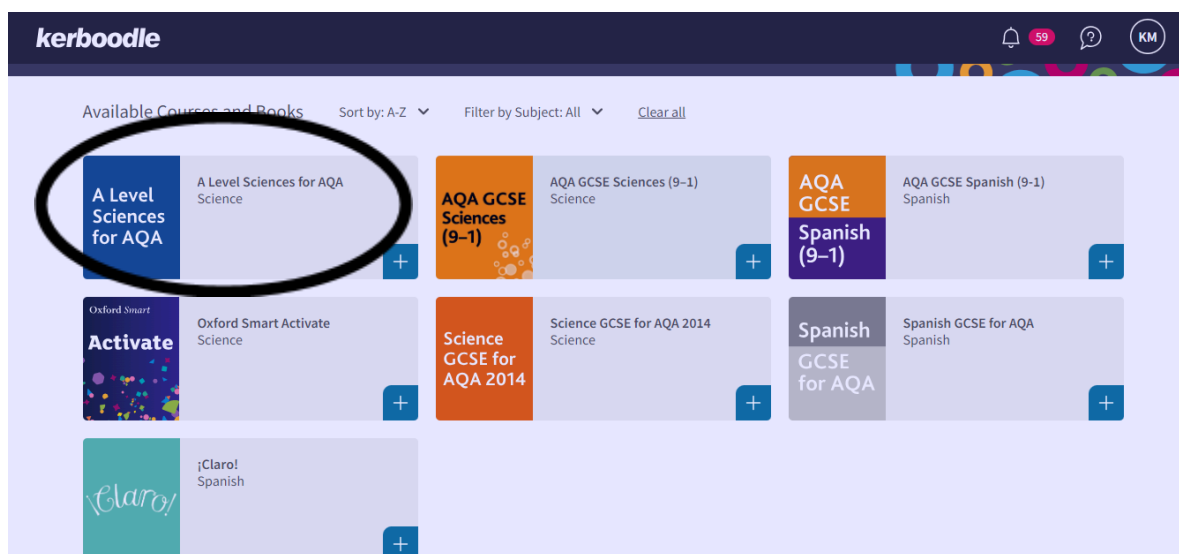
- Biology, Chemistry and Physics studied as Triple Science is also available as displayed below.

What is Kerboodle?

Kerboodle has the following features that students are able to access;

- Online copy of the class textbook for the course they are studying.
- Access to online pieces of work, homeworks and quizzes.

Staff are able to set tasks online for students to complete. When students login they will see a notification bell at the top of their page. This will show what assignments/homeworks have been set by their classroom teacher for them to complete.



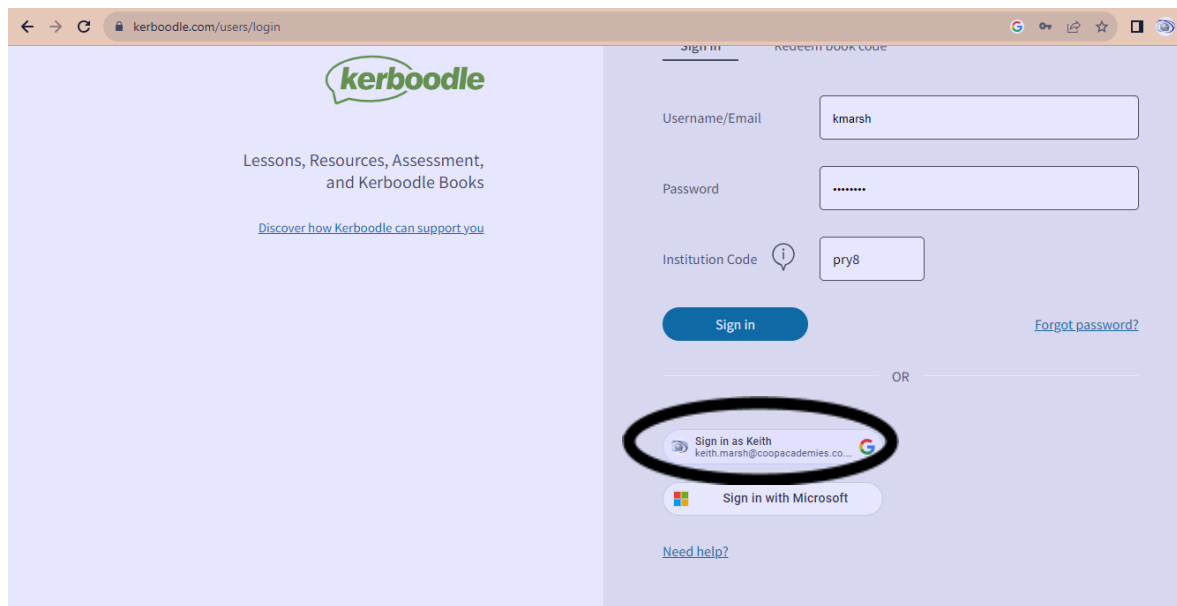
How to sign into Kerboodle.

Students can now use single sign-on to access Kerboodle using their school Google account. This removes the need to remember your Kerboodle sign-in details in addition to your Google details.

The login page has a section towards the bottom which will say “Sign in with google”. Click this.



As long as you are signed into your school google account then it will take you straight to the home page.
